The river views are especially breathtaking at the top of Dubuque's historic Fenelon Place Elevator—the world's shortest, steepest scenic railway, running from Fourth Street to the top of striking river bluffs.

DAY 7: LA CROSSE, WISCONSIN

The fall colors pop along the dramatic bluffs of this beautiful and bustling river port. September marks the beginning of the city's Oktoberfest celebration, emblematic of La Crosse's long and storied history in the brewing industry. Seek out today's thriving brewing establishments, or spend a day exploring the history of this former lumber boomtown in the city's engaging museums and nineteenth-century homes and churches.

DAY 8: RED WING, MINNESOTA

Once known as a busy center for wheat trading, then celebrated for its stoneware and pottery, and finally, a must-see destination for fans of the trendy Red Wing work boots, this city has successfully recast itself time and again. With a multitude of museums and galleries preserving the city's story, Red Wing is symbolic of the ingenuity and potential of small-town America.
